Flood Relief Service



The "Fransalian Association for Social Transformation (FAST) under MSFS Dibrugarh Province has made its first social service as registered NGO by distributing water filters for flood hit villages of Nagaon circle under Dhemaji District. The Nagaon circle consists of Dhanlaguri, Hiloimari, Kajimati, Gadatola and Mukulbari villages. The inhabitants of these villages are mostly Boros and Santhals. The road communications to these villages were cut off due to flood. The area is susceptible to water borne diseases. Therefore, FAST rendered this service of facilitating safe drinking water for the people. Thanks to Fr Jose Chettany, the Director of Social Work in the Province, for the timely help and Fr Peter Parankimalil for availing the fund from the Society.

Training Programme for Fransalian Associates

On July 31, 2022, first ever training programme in the Dibrugarh Province was held for the Fransalian Associates in St Joseph's Parish, Kaying, Arunachal Pradesh. With his passing away, the Church in Northeast India has lost both a Missionary and a Visionary Bishop, who was instrumental in the building up of two dioceses in the Northeast, especially of the Archdiocese of Imphal from its very beginning and in giving impetus to Arunachal Mission in the initial stages.
