## **Focused Plan for the Province**

The focused plan is the result of Superior General's visitation, aspirations of the confreres, elaborate discussion and deliberation of the General Curia and Provincial Curia. This provides the road-map for the future course of action of the Province. Therefore, I request you earnestly dear confreres, to treat this plan as priority and take every required effort to implement it.

### **FOCUSED PLAN OF ACTION (SOUTH-EAST INDIA PROVINCE 2023)**

#### ➤ **RELIGIOS AND COMMUNITY LIFE**

- (1) Praying the Divine Office together as a community with the Blessed Sacrament exposed and celebration of the Eucharist are to be strictly observed every day.
- (2) Monthly community meetings are to be conducted without fail. The following agenda is to be included: (i) Evaluation of community life (ii) Evaluation of the Apostolates (iii) Presentation the monthly statement of accounts. The Minutes of the monthly meeting and the statements of the accounts are to be sent to the Provincial's office by the local superior within two weeks of the meeting.
- (3) Monthly recollections are to be regularized by the local superior. Wherever needed, two or more local communities can come together for monthly recollections.

#### ➤ **MISSION**

- (1) Activate team- based PMP and the formation of Fransalian Associates in the province.
- (2) Train personnel for Parish Mission Preaching and Salesian Retreats.
- (3) Balance parochial ministries with other ministries related to our charism and strengthen the networking of these ministries.
- (4) Work on starting a Retreat centre within three years.

#### ➤ **FORMATION**

- (1) Intensify a scientific English Training in the Minor Seminary. Strictly adhere to the guidelines and criteria of Vocation Promotion by the Province.
- (2) Create opportunities for confreres to come together for update programs and ongoing formation. The groups could be based on the apostolates, apostolic communities, year of ordination, etc.
- (3) Identify and send confreres for formators training programs.

#### ➤ **EDUCATION**

- (1) Implement the financial budgeting system in the schools with the approval of the Provincial Council.



- (2) Strictly observe the Province Statutes regarding the roles of the Correspondent, Principal and Procurator.
- (3) Start the Friends of Fransalians in all the schools within the next three years.
- (4) Start alumni associations in all our schools.
- (5) School buildings and other facilities are to be used for the promotion of education of the less privileged children of the locality. It has to be started in at least two of our schools decided by the education forum.

➤ **SOCIAL AND INNOVATIVE MINISTRY**

- (1) Initiate some sustainable programs such as Evening Schools in the parishes and schools, self-help groups for women, and rehabilitation of street children wherever possible within two years.
- (2) Province MDO has to be strengthened with social and welfare programs. Students who receive scholarship through MDO could be gathered once a year for a seminar or a similar program.
- (3) Social service activities in the province are to be structured.
- (4) Start Fransalian youth units and Friends of Fransalians in our parishes and schools.
- (5) Train confreres for the continuity of the innovative ministries.

➤ **STEWARDSHIP**

- (1) Implement FAST (*Financial Accountability System for Transparency*) in the Province.
- (2) Prepare proper and focused yearly budgeting of all our centres (parishes, schools and communities) and they are to be submitted to the Provincial for approval.
- (3) Internal auditing will be done twice a year in our schools, parishes and all the centres.
- (4) Stewardship Forum meeting will be held at least twice a year (*January and June*) and one of such meetings will have professional financial management training program for the forum members.

### **Establishment of Local Communities**

Dear Confreres, with the approval of the Superior General, the following Local Communities are established:

- i. Kullarayanpalayam in the Diocese of Sultanpet, India;
- ii. Manyani in the Archdiocese of Lilongwe, Malawi;
- iii. Edingeni in the Diocese of Mzuzu, Malawi;
- iv. Ngerenge in the Diocese of Karonga, Malawi;
- v. Livingstonia in the Diocese of Karonga, Malawi; and
- vi. Kameme in the Diocese of Karonga, Malawi.

Establishing them as MSFS Local Communities is part of the process of organization and animation of the Consecrated Life of the community members as per our Constitutions. The directives of the General Chapter 2019 and the Province Statutes are to be strictly followed in the functioning of the Local Community and the role of the Local Superior.

## **Apostolic Communities in Malawi**

It was decided to create two apostolic communities in Malawi for a better functioning. The confreres working in the diocese of Karonga will form one apostolic community, and the confreres working in the archdiocese of Lilongwe and the diocese of Mzuzu will form another. It will come into effect from 15<sup>th</sup> December onwards.
