From the Desk of the Provincial

Dear Confreres,

With immense joy, I greet you on the Feast of our venerable Founder, Servant of God, Father Peter Mermier, an ardent and zealous religious and, an audacious and passionate missionary. We draw inspiration from him for our religious life and spirituality. Father Mermier and his colleagues began to lead religious life in La Roche. Fr. Petitjea who was one of them writes of the first community, "there reigned between the members a sincere cordiality,

simplicity and modes cementing their unity."

Even as a newly ordained priest, Father Mermier chalked out a rule of life for himself and was committed to prayer, work and persevering effort. He was passionate about practicing the evangelical vows unreservedly, much before founding the Congregation. His conviction about poverty is admirable. He wrote for himself the following: "as much as it depends on me, I will have a room without tapestry, without decoration... The Cross or Crucifix that I will have will not be gilt but of simple wood. I will have an earthen-ware holy water stoup. I will observe this same rule of simplicity and poverty with regard to some other necessary furniture: candle-stick, writing-desk, etc. In my room I will never have a mattress on my bed." Fr. Desjacques, to whom Father Mermier was the Curate, saw in him a soul of good will, ardent but docile. Both of them cultivated mutual trust and friendship. Father Mermier, the assistant priest, always sought the counsel and advise of Fr. Desjacques. Both of them lived a meaningful community life at the presbytery of Magland.

Seeking the will of God and being obedient to it was the characteristic that underlined the priestly life of Father Mermier. In December 1815, Mgr. de Solle, Bishop of Chambery wanted Father Mermier to be a professor at Melan. Fr. Desjacques himself said to Father Mermier: "God wants you at Melan." He took up the responsibility joyfully and obediently. At important times of decision making, the advice of Father Desjacques was helpful: "let your soul hear the voice of God. Embrace the Crucifix and listen to it." He learnt to find his will in the will of God. Such a communion of will increases in a communion of thought and sentiment, and thus our will and God's will increasingly coincide (cf. Deus Caritas est, 17).

The way our founder led the first community continues to remain a model for community—living in our times, too. Father Mermier always shared with his colleagues his vision, plans

and desires concerning his new community. He consulted them and sought their advice on important matters (Jean Rey on Father Peter Mermier). He was convinced that obedience includes consultation and being respectful. The members of the community shared all their experiences in the art of preaching and in being all to all. The members, including Father Mermier, played marbles in the parlour during recreation and organized games like children.

Father Mermier surrendered his heart always to God. Nevertheless, it was not easy to make decisions due to his undying missionary spirit. It pained our Founder much that he could not be a part of the pioneering missionaries to India. At La Feuillette, a farewell ceremony was organized during which the feet of those who were leaving were kissed by others. This solemn but emotionally moving ceremony expresses the passionate love of Father Mermier and his respect for the missionaries.

His death anniversary reminds us of our commitment to religious life and missionary life, rooted in community life. Let us mould ourselves further as courageous missionaries, joyful religious, and caring and compassionate confreres. I wish you a very Happy Feast of the Servant of God Father Peter Mermier, our Founder.


Community Conveners and Secretaries and to each confrere who participated enthusiastically, making the day a memorable one for all.

New Parish in the Diocese of Mzuzu in Malawi

Indeed, it is a grace-filled moment for our entire Province as we have taken up a new parish in the



Rodriguez pro-parish, Masasa is our sixth parish in Malawi. We thank God for His abundance of love and gracious gifts at every step of our missionary venture. Fr. Infant Jesus is installed as the parish priest and Fr. Eugine Earnest as the assistant parish priest. The handing-over program took place on 9th August 2024 at 09.00 am. Rev. Fr. Thomas Gondwe, the former Parish Priest, presented the reports in the presence of

Rt. Rev. Yohane, the Auxiliary Bishop of Mzuzu, Rev. Fr. Soosai Raj, MSFS, the Mission Superior, and the Parish committee. The Parish is located in Mzuzu, about three kilometers away from the centre of the town. It adds further value, as this place lies in the middle of our mission stations spread between the centre of the country to the northern borders.

There are around 1,500 Catholics living in this parish. A good number of them attend the daily

Mass. The parish consists of two zones and eleven small Christian communities. The territory of the parish is geographically very terrain. The roads connecting the villages to the main station are muddy and uneven. In the rainy season, it is slippery, making the travel risky and dangerous. The farthest village is 60 kilometers away from the parish and is situated down the hill. The parish has a spacious Church, but the presbytery needs to constructed.



We appreciate Fr. Soosai Raj, the Mission Superior and the confreres in Malawi for their efforts in expanding the mission. We wish Fr. Infant Jesus and Fr. Eugine Earnest all the best and God's abundant blessings as they have taken up this pro-parish with a lot of enthusiasm and commitment.
