My dear Confreres,

We are on the verge of two Solemnities: Ascension and Pentecost. The disciples who sat behind shut doors out of sheer fear and inability to face the cruelties of the outside world “held their breath” as Jesus “breathed on them His Spirit.” For most of the millions of people who died due to the recent Covid pandemic, their last conscious thought must have been “I can’t breathe.” The countless “apocalyptic events” that break upon us from far and near on an hourly basis does indeed “take our breath away.” It is against such existential context that the Pentecost narratives about Jesus breathing on the disciples, and through them on the entire humanity, the gift of the Holy Spirit is to be understood. There are two distinctive features to this Spirit coming down on the disciples. First, he rests on each and, then, brings all of them together in fellowship. On the one hand, to each is given a unique gift, in the form of new and varied charisms, and He causes them to blossom in all its diversity. Indeed, many and varied gifts are given, and yet the result is not to be some sort of savagely selfish competition that foresees the survival of the fit-

test, richest, visibly talented, or the best educated. Rather, the resting of the spirit on the individual, investing him or her with unique gifts, is geared towards creating a new heart, a heart that is capable of receiving the “shalom” of Christ by letting itself be renewed by forgiveness and self-correction and broadening itself to embrace the unique diversity of all others. Thus, the same Spirit that gives each individual a unique gift gathers them all into unity. In other words, the same Spirit creates diversity and unity, and in this way forms a new, diverse, and unified fellowship. This, precisely, is the heart of consecrated life as well!

Just as we are all gearing up to begin a new academic year, the solemnities of Ascension and Pentecost tell us that God calls us, anoints us with his Spirit, and sends us out to make a difference as members of a Spirit-formed and Spirit-filled religious community, enriched with varied charisms as individuals, but bound together into our Fransalian fellowship. What Jesus said at Ascension still remains valid and indispensable: You be My witness – and in our case, His witnesses as Fransalians of the South-West Province.



SUPERIOR GENERAL'S CANONICAL VISITATION

It is with great joy that I share with you all the news about the forthcoming canonical visitation of our beloved Superior General to our South-West India Province. The scheduled dates are the following: **Arrival - September 09, 2023; Visitation from September 10 to October 04, 2023. The visitation will begin from Trivandrum and will conclude in Bangalore.** The detailed schedule of Fr. General's visitation will be announced in the next circular. Superior General's visitation is primarily a spiritual event and it is an occasion to reflect, share, learn, and to plan out our common religious life and ministries. Therefore, it calls for serious preparation both at the individual and community levels. I invite all of you to prepare this sacred occasion in such a way that it becomes truly an enriching and reinvigorating experience for all of us in the Province. Fr. General has explicitly stated that he is focussed on meeting all the confreres in the communities and special care should be taken to avoid all sorts of gala events and programmes, especially in the institutions. He wishes it to be a simple family, fraternal experience.

DISPLAY OF THE CHARISM

During the last Extraordinary General Chapter held in Pune we have articulated our MSFS Charism in a single sentence for the sake of uniformity and clarity. Our Superior General has directed us to display this articulation of our Charism in all our communities, formation houses, and residence in a visible way. Let our charism become clear and visible to us and those who visit MSFS communities.

There are three constituent elements to our Charism. The first one is to continue the mission of Christ and His Church. The second element is living the spirit and spirituality of St. Francis de Sales. The third element is living in a religious community as lived and envisioned by our Founder.

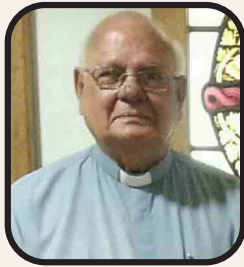
