AN IMPORTANT DECISION REGARDING OUR NEW BATCH OF THEOLOGIANS

Our Province had conceived the whole Kengeri campus as a multi-faceted campus of missionary initiatives in order to provide a mission-oriented, contextualized theological formation for our young generations of new priests. Due to various problems like land-issues and the consequent inability to provide adequate infra-structure as well as non-availability of sufficient number of qualified and competent resident staff and so forth, the programme could never be fully materialized as it was envisioned. Specifically speaking, the following concerns have become too serious today to be ignored: (1) Tejas does not have even the bare minimum infrastructural facilities; (2) it lacks by far adequate number of qualified and competent residential staff; and (3) the industrial developments in the surroundings has made the place absolutely unfit for a theologate.

Our last Provincial Chapter had delved on the issues in depth and had serious discussions about shifting Tejas to an entirely new campus, which has meanwhile proved to be almost impractical on many counts. Because of the serious limitations, the ideals as well as the effectivity of a mission-oriented contextual theological formation stand highly compromised today. Taking these and many other factors into account, the Provincial Administration has taken a unanimous decision not to send the next batch of scholastics to Tejas Vidya Peetha (for the academic year beginning from 2024-2025) and send them instead to St. Peter's Pontifical Seminary, Bangalore, and St. Joseph's Pontifical Seminary, Mangalapuzha, as resident seminarians. This decision has been approved by our Superior General. A definitive decision as to whether we want to continue with the Tejas theologate or stop the Tejas programme altogether as the current batches complete their formation there, shall be taken after the coming Mid-term Assembly in July 2024.
