My dear Confreres,




Prayerful wishes to each one of you from Vinayalaya. As we are celebrating the year of St Francis de Sales with various commonly arranged programmes at various levels to mark the 400th Anniversary of his death, we are invited to grow a little closer to him personally and be inspired by his missionary spirit. Jean-Luc Leroux in one of his essays on St Francis de

Sales writes of an aspect of Francis de Sales' apostolate, probably an unfamiliar one, that he calls the "apostolate of contact." To quote the author: "Francis de Sales had Jesus in his eyes as in his heart. Francis went ordinarily by foot, by pastoral choice, as was the habit quite simply of a rustic gentleman; this manner permitted him to encounter workers in their shops, the peasants in their fields or villages. Thereby he established a simple relation, person-to-person. By way of such a relationship, when sympathy is established, the friend then became in turn his witness in relation to his own friends. The apostolate of contact is a beginning. He followed it by his preaching." Establishing person-to-person contact marked by the simplicity of our lifestyle could be something that each of us could personalize in this year of St Francis de Sales. And we have just celebrated the feast of St John Vianney, the patron saint of priests, whose life has not only been a great example of how we priests can use our strengths to mitigate our weaknesses, taking what one is good at and learning to excel at them, but also an eternal reminder to all of us that true love of Christ in a priest should manifest itself primarily through guileless prayer and service.

SHANTHI DHAM

he very name, Shanthi Dham, itself may be largely unfamiliar to you. We may all be well aware of the fact that Fr A. Anthony Swamy, even before his return to India after his pastoral ministry in the USA, was deeply reflecting upon starting a home for the dying destitute. Besides spending quality time in personal prayer and reflection, he has been going around in order to have first-hand lived-in experience of the existential challenges of such a centre as well as studying the financial and other obligations that such a venture would bring in. During the entire discerning process he has been in constant touch with the provincial administrations. Now it is time to inform the entire province that the decision is finally made to begin a new project titled Shanthi Dham, *home for peace*, within the premises of Saumya Sadan in Mysore under the initiative and leadership of Fr Anthony Swamy as the latest missionary undertaking of our Province.

As per the plan of the Mysore city development authority, a big road is being made that runs right through our land of Saumya Sadan, dividing the land into two pieces, one consisting of around 1.25 acres where the present building exists and the other consisting of a little over 3 acres where the coconut garden is. The proposed Shanthi Dham will be constructed on the first piece of land and the existing building would be incorporated into its structural plan. The province could initiate some other ministry utilizing the other larger piece of land which has an added advantage of having independent road access because of the new road being made.

Shanthi Dham aims to provide care, compassion, and love for the poor and destitute who have no hope in life due to terminal illness, old age or other health issues with no medical remedy or treatment available to them. The Mission of Shanthi Dham is to restore human dignity to such dying destitute and poor who are unwanted, rejected, or abandoned by the family and community and to create a home that could give love, care, and compassion, so that they experience happiness, acceptance, peace, and die with dignity. Single-handedly, Fr Anthony Swamy is generating the required funds for putting up the necessary infrastructure as well as meeting the running cost. On behalf of all of us in the South-West India Province, I thank Fr Anthony Swamy most sincerely for his courageous and daring initiative and for his untiring efforts to ensure the smooth taking off of the project at the earliest.

It is also very clear that such a project cannot be sustained with the efforts of just one person. Fr Thund-uparambil Abey has expressed his love for such a project and is appointed as the Administrator of the Shanthi Dham project. He will continue to be the Dean of Studies at Sannidhi for the time being and will continue to reside there until someone is appointed to replace him. The project of Shanthi Dham requires further volunteers to ensure its stability. If one or the other member in our Province would like to volunteer to join such a noble cause, it would contribute a lot towards stabilizing such a demanding project. Please do give a serious thought.

VIKASIYOTHI RESTRUCTURING

IKASJYOTHI, the Mission Development Office (MDO) of the South-West India Province, established at the MSFS House, Mysore on 23rd January 2018, has been envisaged primarily as a Mission Procure of the Province functioning as a Fransalian Resource Centre for Integral Human

Development. Fr Cherukat Thomas was appointed the Founder-Director of Vikasjyothi with effect from 1st January 2018. Within its short existence, it has already helped several of our mission projects as indicated in the newsletter of Vikas Jyothi. The province is immensely grateful to Fr Cherukat Thomas for his passionate commitment to the cause of our missions and for his untiring efforts in raising and dispersing funds for our missionary undertakings. At the request of Fr Thomas Cherukat and in view of facilitating greater involvement of the entire Province in the mission of Vikasjyothi as well as making Vikasjyothi reach out to more needy causes, it is decided to restructure its administration and management into a three-tier apparatus consisting of a **Governing Body, Administrative Body** and an **Executive Body** with **Associate Members in each continent who would be the official contact persons** for the director. All the executive decisions like processing applications, screening requests, as well as making decisions will be taken by the executive body.

outh-West India Province is known for its vibrant inner dynamism in promoting and nurturing new and bold initiatives making its ministry respond effectively to the requirements of the times. Opening centres to assist the youth in toning and developing their skills and talents has been one such response to the needs of our times. Fr Santhosh Kumar has been making our Province proud since 2010, with the music academy he founded and the spectacular manner in which it has served the people of the locality. With due permission from the previous provincial administration and with the financial support of several kind-hearted people from abroad and India, Fr Santhosh Kumar had already embarked upon putting up the necessary facilities for another venture in the form of a language academy adjacent to the music academy. This academy is envisaged towards the empowerment of youth, especially the jobless rural youth, children, and women. After unforeseen delays due to the pandemic, the building has just been completed and was blessed by his grace Archbishop Peter Machado on 30th July 2022. While congratulating and thanking Fr Santhosh Kumar for all his efforts, we wish him all the best in this new venture.

EXTENSION OF DATA TO KATTAPPANA

SFS Community at Kattappana was in the pastoral plans of our Province right from the beginning. Although the land there was bought with the original vision of venturing into educational ministry, the vision could not be materialized for various reasons. Eventually, a full-fledged centre was established there as an extension of our spiritual assistance to the people of the area through counselling, Spiritual Direction, Retreats, and other religious and spiritual programmes, coming under the jurisdiction of the diocese of Vijayapuram. Fr Puthiaparambil Johny not only visualized and took the initiative in establishing the centre but also found the bulk of the financial resources to put up the current structure. Different programmes were initiated in the form of group retreats, renewal seminars, family counselling and individual guidance. But the outbreak of the Corona pandemic had such a debilitating effect on the ongoing programs and unfortunately, a healthy revival in the foreseeable future looked bleak. At the suggestion of Fr Johny himself that it may be better on the part of the Province to look for other effective alternative forms of ministry, the provincial administration, after considering various options, has decided to make use of the facilities at Kattappana as an extension of DATA, De Sales Academy for Talent assistance at Aluva, with a specifically worked out package for this campus. The director as well as the programme coordinator will be Fr Plathottathil Jino and all the local arrangements, including the running of the hostel, will be under the care of Fr Mangalathu Joshy and Fr Kollarayathu Jaison. After slight restructuring of the existing facilities to suit the requirements of such an institute as DATA, the programme itself is scheduled to start functioning by the middle of August 2022.
